RESOLUTION No. 1363

(Adopted on 29 June 2018 by the Council at its Second Special Session)

ADMISSION OF THE LAO PEOPLE'S DEMOCRATIC REPUBLIC AS A MEMBER OF THE ORGANIZATION

The Council,

Having received the request of the Lao People's Democratic Republic for admission as a Member of the Organization (C/Sp/2/4),

Having been informed that the Lao People's Democratic Republic accepts the Constitution of the Organization, has completed all the required internal procedures according to its constitution and applicable rules and has undertaken to make a financial contribution to the administrative requirements of the Organization,

Considering that the Lao People's Democratic Republic has demonstrated its interest in the principle of the free movement of persons as stated in Article 2(b) of the Constitution,

Convinced that the Lao People's Democratic Republic could give valuable assistance towards furthering the purposes of the Organization,

- 1. Decides to admit the Lao People's Democratic Republic as a Member of the International Organization for Migration, in accordance with the provisions of Article 2(b) of the Constitution, as from the date of adoption of the present resolution;
- 2. Also decides to determine its contribution to the Administrative Part of the 2018 Budget at 0.0032 per cent thereof.
