RESOLUTION No. 1314

(Adopted on 30 June 2016 by the Council at its First Special Session)

ADMISSION OF SOLOMON ISLANDS AS A MEMBER OF THE ORGANIZATION

The Council,

Having received the request of Solomon Islands for admission as a Member of the Organization (C/Sp/1/3),

Having been informed that Solomon Islands accepts the Constitution of the Organization, has completed all the required internal procedures according to its constitution and applicable rules and has undertaken to make a financial contribution to the administrative requirements of the Organization,

Considering that Solomon Islands has demonstrated its interest in the principle of the free movement of persons as stated in Article 2(b) of the Constitution,

Convinced that Solomon Islands could give valuable assistance towards furthering the purposes of the Organization,

1. *Decides* to admit Solomon Islands as a Member of the International Organization for Migration, in accordance with the provisions of Article 2(b) of the Constitution, as from the date of the present resolution;

2. *Also decides* to determine its contribution to the Administrative Part of the 2016 Budget at 0.0011 per cent thereof.
