# ACCEPTANCE OF THE AMENDMENTS TO THE CONSTITUTION

## ACCEPTANCE OF THE AMENDMENTS TO THE CONSTITUTION

- 1. At its Seventy-sixth Session, the Council adopted amendments to the Constitution (Council Resolution No. 997 of 24 November 1998). According to Article 30, paragraph 2, of the Constitution, the entry into force of the amendments is subject to acceptance, in accordance with their respective constitutional processes, by two thirds of the Member States.
- 2. These amendments aim at strengthening the structure and streamlining the decision-making process of IOM. They represent an important development for the future of the Organization. The Council, in the above-mentioned resolution and again in Council Resolution No. 1013 of 1 December 1999, called upon the Member States to accept these amendments as early as possible and to inform the Director General accordingly. Similar calls have been made over time by various Chairpersons of the Council and the Director General of IOM to States that had not yet accepted the amendments. The IOM Legal Counsel continues to conduct meetings with ambassadors and other senior staff of these States to further advance the acceptance of the amendments.
- 3. To date, 88 States have notified the Director General of their acceptance of the amendments (see Annex I), out of a total membership of 146 States. In order for the amendments to enter into force, ratifications are required from two thirds of the Member States which currently is 98 ratifications.
- 4. Member States that have not yet accepted the amendments (see Annex II) are once again invited to do so as soon as possible as a matter of priority and to notify the Director General accordingly.
