RESOLUTION No. 1274

(Adopted on 25 November 2014 by the Council at its 105th Session)

ADMISSION OF THE INDEPENDENT STATE OF SAMOA AS A MEMBER OF THE ORGANIZATION

The Council,

Having received the request of the Independent State of Samoa for admission as a Member of the Organization (C/105/44),

Having been informed that the Independent State of Samoa accepts the Constitution of the Organization, has completed all the required internal procedures according to its constitution and applicable rules and has undertaken to make a financial contribution to the administrative requirements of the Organization,

Considering that the Independent State of Samoa has demonstrated its interest in the principle of the free movement of persons as stated in Article 2(b) of the Constitution,

Convinced that the Independent State of Samoa could give valuable assistance towards furthering the purposes of the Organization,

Resolves:

1. That the Independent State of Samoa be admitted as a Member of the International Organization for Migration, in accordance with the provisions of Article 2(b) of the Constitution, as from the date of the present resolution;

2. That its contribution to the Administrative Part of the Budget be determined at 0.0011 per cent thereof.
