- 1. In a letter dated 17 April 2014, a copy of which is appended as Annex I, the Secretary General of INTERSOS made a formal application for his Organization to be accorded observer status at meetings of the IOM Council. The Director General's reply thereto, dated 30 September 2014 is appended as Annex II. An appropriate item will be included on the provisional agenda of the 105th Session of the Council.
- 2. This matter falls under rule 10 of the Rules of Procedure of the Council which provides that the Council may admit, upon their application, international organizations, governmental or non-governmental, concerned with migration, refugees or human resources as observers at its meetings.
- 3. An appropriate draft resolution will be submitted to the Council when this matter comes up for decision.

### LETTER DATED 17 APRIL 2014 FROM THE SECRETARY GENERAL OF INTERSOS TO THE DIRECTOR GENERAL OF THE INTERNATIONAL ORGANIZATION FOR MIGRATION

## LETTER DATED 30 SEPTEMBER 2014 FROM THE DIRECTOR GENERAL OF THE INTERNATIONAL ORGANIZATION FOR MIGRATION TO THE SECRETARY GENERAL OF INTERSOS

Dear Mr. Secretary General,

I have the pleasure to refer to your letter of 17 April 2014 seeking observer status for INTERSOS in the International Organization for Migration (IOM).
