- 1. In a letter dated 12 November 2014, a copy of which is appended as Annex I, the Secretary-General of the World Meteorological Organization made a formal application for his Organization to be accorded observer status at meetings of the IOM Council. The Director General's reply thereto, dated 18 November 2014, is appended as Annex II. An appropriate item will be included on the provisional agenda of the 105th Session of the Council.
- 2. This matter falls under rule 10 of the Rules of Procedure for the Council which provides that the Council may admit, upon their application, international organizations, governmental or non-governmental, concerned with migration, refugees or human resources as observers at its meetings.
- 3. An appropriate draft resolution will be submitted to the Council when this matter comes up for decision.

LETTER DATED 12 NOVEMBER 2014 FROM THE SECRETARY-GENERAL OF THE WORLD METEOROLOGICAL ORGANIZATION TO THE DIRECTOR GENERAL OF THE INTERNATIONAL ORGANIZATION FOR MIGRATION

LETTER DATED 18 NOVEMBER 2014 FROM THE DIRECTOR GENERAL OF THE INTERNATIONAL ORGANIZATION FOR MIGRATION TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL OF THE WORLD METEOROLOGICAL ORGANIZATION

I have the pleasure to refer to your letter of 12 November 2014 seeking observer status for the World Meteorological Organization (WMO) in the International Organization for Migration (IOM).

I note with appreciation the role of WMO in protecting life and property and in enhancing the economic and social well-being of all sectors of society through facilitating the free and unrestricted international exchange of basic meteorological data and products. I also highly appreciate WMO's participation in IOM's side event entitled "How to Integrate Migration into Adaptation Strategies & Planning" at the 18th Conference of the Parties to the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change in Doha, Qatar. With the existing collaboration between WMO and IOM within the HLCP's Working Group on Climate Change, and IOM's participation in WMO's recent Conference on Gender Dimensions of Weather and Climate Services, as well as the information sharing between our respective organizations relating to the impact of climate change on migration, it is my belief that both our organizations could benefit from a further strengthening of this relationship.
