- 1. In a letter dated 12 November 2010, a copy of which is appended as Annex I, the Secretary-General of the Economic Community of Central African States (ECCAS) made a formal application for his organization to be accorded observer status at meetings of the IOM Council. The Director General's reply thereto, dated 24 February 2011, is appended as Annex II. An appropriate item will be included on the provisional agenda of the Hundredth Session of the Council.
- 2. This matter falls under rule 10 of the Rules of Procedure for the Council, which provides that the Council may admit, upon their application, international organizations, governmental and non-governmental, concerned with migration, refugees or human resources as observers at its meetings.
- 3. An appropriate draft resolution will be submitted to the Council when this matter comes up for decision.
