- 1. In a letter dated 25 October 2011, the Federated States of Micronesia applied for membership in the International Organization for Migration. A copy of the letter and of the Director General's reply, dated 28 October 2011, are annexed.
- 2. In accordance with Article 2 (b) of the Constitution, the Council is required to make a decision regarding the application of the Federated States of Micronesia for membership and the rate of its contribution to the administrative requirements of the Organization, which the Director General recommends should be assessed at 0.0011 per cent of the total contributions required from Member States to the Administrative Part of the Budget.
- 3. An appropriate draft resolution will be submitted to the Council for consideration.
