APPLICATION BY THE REPUBLIC OF VANUATU FOR MEMBERSHIP IN THE ORGANIZATION

- 1. In a letter dated 25 November 2011, the Republic of Vanuatu applied for membership in the International Organization for Migration. The letter and the Director General's reply, dated 30 November 2011, are reproduced in the annexes to this document.
- 2. In accordance with Article 2(b) of the Constitution, the Council is required to make a decision regarding the application of the Republic of Vanuatu for membership and the rate of its financial contribution to the administrative requirements of the Organization, which the Director General recommends should be assessed at 0.0011 per cent of the total contributions required from Member States to the Administrative Part of the Budget.
- 3. An appropriate draft resolution will be submitted to the Council for consideration.

LETTER DATED 25 NOVEMBER 2011 FROM THE MINISTER OF FOREIGN AFFAIRS OF THE REPUBLIC OF VANUATU TO THE DIRECTOR GENERAL OF THE INTERNATIONAL ORGANIZATION FOR MIGRATION

I have the honour to refer to the relationship existing between the Government of the Republic of Vanuatu and the International Organization for Migration (IOM).

The Government of the Republic of Vanuatu wishes to establish a closer relationship with the Organization and hereby applies for membership in the International Organization for Migration in accordance with Article 2, paragraph (b) of the IOM Constitution.

The Government of the Republic of Vanuatu accepts the Constitution, and the amendments thereto of the 24th November 1998, in accordance with its constitutional processes and the obligations resulting from membership. It also undertakes to make a financial contribution to the administrative requirements of the Organization, the rate of which will be agreed upon by the IOM Council and Government of the Republic of Vanuatu.
