APPLICATION BY GEORGIA FOR MEMBERSHIP IN THE ORGANIZATION

- 1. In a letter dated 3 May 2001, Georgia applied for membership in the International Organization for Migration. A copy of the foregoing letter and of the Deputy Director General's reply, dated 22 May 2001, are annexed.
- 2. In accordance with Article 2 (b) of the Constitution, the Council is required to make a decision regarding the application of Georgia for membership and the rate of its contribution to the administrative requirements of the Organization, which the Director General recommends should be assessed at 0.050 per cent of the total contributions required from Member States to the Administrative part of the Budget.
- 3. An appropriate draft resolution will be submitted for consideration by the Council.

LETTER DATED 3 MAY 2001 FROM THE MINISTER
OF FOREIGN AFFAIRS OF GEORGIA

LETTER DATED 22 MAY 2001 FROM THE DEPUTY DIRECTOR GENERAL OF THE INTERNATIONAL ORGANIZATION FOR MIGRATION TO THE MINISTER OF FOREIGN AFFAIRS OF GEORGIA

A document formally presenting your Government's application for membership will be distributed to all Member States and Observers. You will receive a copy of it, together with further details and procedural information concerning the Council session.
