### APPLICATION BY THE REPUBLIC OF GUYANA FOR REPRESENTATION BY AN OBSERVER

- 1. In a letter dated 31 March 2005, a copy of which is appended as Annex I, the Minister of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Guyana made a formal application for his country to be accorded observer status at meetings of the IOM Council. The Director General's reply, dated 14 April 2005, is appended as Annex II. An appropriate item will be included in the provisional agenda for the Council's Eighty-ninth (Special) Session.
- 2. This matter falls under Rule 10 of the Rules of Procedure for the Council, which provides that the Council may admit, upon their application, non-member States as observers at its meetings.
- 3. If the Council so decides, the Republic of Guyana will be included among the non-member States listed in paragraph 1 of Resolution No. 753 (LVIII).
- 4. An appropriate draft resolution will be submitted to the Council when this matter comes up for decision.
