APPLICATION BY THE SOCIALIST REPUBLIC OF VIET NAM FOR MEMBERSHIP IN THE ORGANIZATION

- 1. In a letter dated 14 November 2007, the Socialist Republic of Viet Nam applied for membership in the International Organization for Migration. A copy of the letter and of the Director General's reply, dated 20 November 2007, are annexed.
- 2. In accordance with Article 2 (b) of the Constitution, the Council is required to make a decision regarding the application of the Socialist Republic of Viet Nam for membership and the rate of its contribution to the administrative requirements of the Organization, which the Director General recommends should be assessed at 0.026 per cent of the total contributions required from Member States to the Administrative Part of the Budget.
- 3. An appropriate draft resolution will be submitted to the Council for consideration.

LETTER DATED 14 NOVEMBER 2007 FROM THE DEPUTY PRIME MINISTER, MINISTER FOR FOREIGN AFFAIRS OF THE SOCIALIST REPUBLIC OF VIET NAM TO THE DIRECTOR GENERAL OF THE INTERNATIONAL ORGANIZATION FOR MIGRATION

It is my great pleasure and honour to inform you that the Government of the Socialist Republic of Vietnam hereby decides to apply for membership in the International Organization for Migration (IOM) in accordance with Article 2, paragraph (b) of the IOM Constitution.

The Government of the Socialist Republic of Vietnam accepts the Constitution, and the amendments thereto of 24 November 1998, in accordance with its constitutional processes and the obligations resulting from membership. It also undertakes to make a financial contribution to the administrative requirements of the Organization, the rate of which will be agreed upon by the IOM Council and the Government of Vietnam.

The Government and people of the Socialist Republic of Vietnam highly appreciate the fruitful cooperation, which has long been established between the Government of Vietnam and the International Organization for Migration. We always value the assistance given by IOM to facilitate our efforts in managing the migration issues. I strongly believe that with Vietnam's full membership, our cooperation will be further enhanced for the benefit of our people.

LETTER DATED 20 NOVEMBER 2007 FROM THE DIRECTOR GENERAL OF THE INTERNATIONAL ORGANIZATION FOR MIGRATION TO THE DEPUTY PRIME MINISTER, MINISTER FOR FOREIGN AFFAIRS OF THE SOCIALIST REPUBLIC OF VIET NAM
