### APPLICATION BY MONGOLIA FOR MEMBERSHIP IN THE ORGANIZATION

- 1. In a letter dated 30 April 2008, Mongolia applied for membership in the International Organization for Migration. A copy of the letter and of the Director General's reply, dated 7 May 2008, are annexed.
- 2. In accordance with Article 2 (b) of the Constitution, the Council is required to make a decision regarding the application of Mongolia for membership and the rate of its contribution to the administrative requirements of the Organization, which the Director General recommends should be assessed at 0.026 per cent of the total contributions required from Member States to the Administrative Part of the Budget.
- 3. An appropriate draft resolution will be submitted to the Council for consideration.

# LETTER DATED 30 APRIL 2008 FROM THE MINISTER FOR FOREIGN AFFAIRS OF MONGOLIA TO THE DIRECTOR GENERAL OF THE INTERNATIONAL ORGANIZATION FOR MIGRATION

Sir,

I have the honour to refer to the relationship existing between the Government of Mongolia and the International Organization for Migration (IOM).

My Government wishes to establish a closer relationship with your Organization and hereby applies for membership in the International Organization for Migration in accordance with Article 2, paragraph (b) of the IOM Constitution.

It also undertakes to make a financial contribution to the administrative requirements of the Organization, the rate of which shall be agreed upon by the IOM Council and Mongolia.
