ACCEPTANCE OF THE AMENDMENTS TO THE CONSTITUTION

ACCEPTANCE OF THE AMENDMENTS TO THE CONSTITUTION

- 1. On 24 November 1998, the Council adopted amendments to the Constitution (Resolution No. 997). According to Article 30, paragraph 2, of the Constitution, the entry into force of the amendments is subject to acceptance, in accordance with their respective constitutional processes, by two thirds of the Member States.
- 2. These amendments aim at strengthening the structure and streamlining the decision-making process of IOM. They represent an important development for the future of the Organization. The Council, in the above-mentioned resolution and again in Resolution No. 1013 of 1 December 1999, called upon Member States to accept these amendments as early as possible and to inform the Director General accordingly. A similar call was made by the Chairman of the Council in a letter dated 23 November 2005 and sent to States that had not yet accepted the amendments. The matter was also raised on various occasions in the consultations leading up to the adoption of the IOM strategy in 2007.
- 3. To date, only 55 States have notified the Director General of their acceptance of the amendments (see Annex), out of a total membership of 125 States.
- 4. Member States which have not yet accepted the amendments are once again invited to do so as soon as possible and to notify the Director General accordingly.
