- 1. In a letter dated 29 January 2010, received on 29 March 2010, the Kingdom of Lesotho applied for membership in the International Organization for Migration. A copy of the letter and of the Director General's reply, dated 13 April 2010, are annexed.
- 2. In accordance with Article 2 (b) of the Constitution, the Council is required to make a decision regarding the application of the Kingdom of Lesotho for membership and the rate of its contribution to the administrative requirements of the Organization, which the Director General recommends should be assessed at 0.0011 per cent of the total contributions required from Member States to the Administrative Part of the Budget.
- 3. An appropriate draft resolution will be submitted to the Council for consideration.

LETTER DATED 29 JANUARY 2010 FROM THE MINISTER FOR FOREIGN AFFAIRS AND INTERNATIONAL RELATIONS OF THE KINGDOM OF LESOTHO TO THE DIRECTOR GENERAL OF THE INTERNATIONAL ORGANIZATION FOR MIGRATION
