- 1. In a letter dated 2 November 2010, the Republic of Botswana applied for membership in the International Organization for Migration. A copy of the letter and of the Director General's reply, dated 11 November 2010, are annexed.
- 2. In accordance with Article 2 (b) of the Constitution, the Council is required to make a decision regarding the application of the Republic of Botswana for membership and the rate of its contribution to the administrative requirements of the Organization, which the Director General recommends should be assessed at 0.0195 per cent of the total contributions required from Member States to the Administrative Part of the Budget.
- 3. An appropriate draft resolution will be submitted to the Council for consideration.

LETTER DATED 2 NOVEMBER 2010 FROM THE MINISTER OF LABOUR AND HOME AFFAIRS OF THE REPUBLIC OF BOTSWANA TO THE DIRECTOR GENERAL OF THE INTERNATIONAL ORGANIZATION FOR MIGRATION
