RESOLUTION No. 1044 (LXXXI)

ADMISSION OF GEORGIA AS A MEMBER OF THE ORGANIZATION

The Council,

Having received the request of Georgia for admission as a Member of the Organization (MC/2032),

Having been informed that Georgia accepts the Constitution of the Organization in accordance with its internal constitutional processes and has undertaken to make a financial contribution to the administrative requirements of the Organization,

Considering that Georgia has demonstrated its interest in the principle of the free movement of persons as stated in Article 2 (b) of the Constitution,

Convinced that Georgia could give valuable assistance towards furthering the purposes of the Organization,

Resolves:

- 1. That Georgia be admitted as a Member of the International Organization for Migration, in accordance with the provisions of Article 2 (b) of the Constitution, as from the date of the present resolution;
- 2. That its contribution to the Administrative part of the Budget be determined at 0.050 per cent thereof.
