RESOLUTION No. 177 (IX)

MOVEMENT OF REFUGEES OF EUROPEAN ORIGIN FROM THE FAR EAST

The Council of the Intergovernmental Committee for European Migration,

Having received from the Director a report on the movement of refugees of European origin from the Far East;

Noting with appreciation the continuing interest of Member Governments which is essential to the movement of these refugees;

Considering that it is of the highest importance that additional resources be made available to ensure the early and continuing movement of the more than 9,000 refugees remaining in great anxiety in China;

Resolves:

- 1. To authorize the Director, after proper consultation with the United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees, to appeal urgently to Governments for special contributions to finance the transportation of these refugees; and
- 2. To reaffirm its instructions to the Director, contained in Resolution No. 166 (VIII), namely, to ensure in close collaboration with the United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees, the continuation of the operations now in progress to the extent that the costs thereof are fully covered by contributions made specifically for this purpose.
