RESOLUTION No. 22

(Adopted at the 23rd meeting on 12 June 1952)

**ESTABLISHMENT OF A SUB-COMMITTEE ON FINANCE**

*The Provisional Intergovernmental Committee for the Movement of Migrants from Europe,*

*Considering:*

The need for a careful and continued survey of the financial situation of the Provisional Intergovernmental Committee;

The necessity of advising the Director on all matters relating to the budget, plan of expenditure and finance; and

The advisability of preparing the work of the Committee in such matters;

*Bearing in mind* the provisions of paragraph 6 of the enabling Resolution (PIC/22/Rev.1, Annex I) concerning the establishment of sub-committees,

*Resolves:*

1. That there shall be established a Sub-Committee on Finance, composed of representatives of the following countries: Australia, Canada, France, Germany, Italy, the Netherlands and the United States of America.

2. That the Sub-Committee on Finance shall meet:

(a) Before each session of the Committee;

(b) At the call of the Director; and

(c) At the request of three members of the Sub-Committee.

3. That the functions of the Sub-Committee on Finance shall be:

- (a) To study all budgetary and financial questions and to transmit its recommendations thereon to the Committee;
- (b) To advise the Director on budgetary and financial matters, and to take decisions on the same matters on behalf of the Committee if an emergency arises and the Committee cannot be convened, such decisions to be submitted to the Committee at its following session for approval.
