RESOLUTION No. 43

(Adopted at the 39th meeting on 21 October 1952)

REFUGEES FROM TRIESTE

The Provisional Intergovernmental Committee for the Movement of Migrants from Europe,

Noting the very grave situation of the refugees in Trieste;

Considering that a large number of families of refugees could emigrate overseas if a possibility or resettlement in Europe could be offered to those members of such families who are at present, for various reasons, unable to emigrate;

Taking note of the generous example already given by certain countries in that respect,

Requests the Director to contact the United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees, the governments concerned and the voluntary agencies, in order to facilitate the resettlement of "hard core cases" in all countries willing to receive them, and to take appropriate steps to bring about the emigration overseas of the greatest number of families of refugees in Trieste.
