RESOLUTION No. 77

(Adopted at the 72nd meeting on 30 November 1954)

COMING INTO FORCE OF THE CONSTITUTION

The Intergovernmental Committee for European Migration,

Recalling:

That by Resolution No. 56 it recommended Member Governments to accept the Constitution attached to the said Resolution and to notify the Director of their acceptance at the earliest possible date;

That by Resolution No. 57 it resolved to hold a session within ninety days of the Director's having received the notification as laid down in Article 33 of the Constitution;

Having received the Report of the Director concerning the coming into force of the Constitution;

Affirming:

That sixteen Member Governments, representing 81.51 per cent of the contributions to the Administrative part of the Budget, having communicated to the Director their acceptance of the Constitution;

That the Eighth Session of the Committee is to be considered as the session envisaged by Resolution No. 57;

That the conditions set forth in Article 33 of the Constitution for the coming into force of this Constitution are fulfilled,

Resolves:

1. To declare the Constitution of the Committee in force on 30 November 1954, in accordance with Article 33 of the said Constitution;

- 2. To convene the First Session of the Council on 30 November 1954;
- 3. To transmit to the Council the documents submitted to the Committee.
