The Council,

Bearing in mind the provisions of Article 8 of the Constitution,

Recalling its decision in Resolution No. 753 (LVIII) of 29 November 1988 concerning the attendance of observers at meetings of the Council,

Resolves:

- 1. To invite Ireland to designate observers to its meetings;
- 2. To amend Resolution No. 753 (LVIII) by adding Ireland to the list of non-member States contained in paragraph 1 of the said resolution.
