RESOLUTION No. 96 (II)

(Adopted at the 10th meeting on 27 April 1955)

**ADMISSION OF THE GOVERNMENT OF NEW ZEALAND
AS A MEMBER OF THE COMMITTEE**

The Council of the Intergovernmental Committee for European Migration,

Having been informed that the Government of New Zealand has requested admission as a Member of the Committee, accepts the Constitution and has undertaken to make a financial contribution at least to the administrative requirements of the Committee;

Aware of the interest in the principle of the free movement of persons demonstrated by the aforesaid Government;

Convinced that the aforesaid Government could give valuable assistance towards furthering the purposes of the Committee,

Resolves:

1. That the Government of New Zealand be admitted as a Member of the Intergovernmental Committee for European Migration, in accordance with the provisions of Article 2 (b) of the Constitution, as from the date of this Resolution; and
2. That its contribution to the Administrative part of the Budget of the Committee be determined at 1.02 per cent thereof.
