APPLICATION BY THE COOK ISLANDS FOR MEMBERSHIP IN THE ORGANIZATION

APPLICATION BY THE COOK ISLANDS FOR MEMBERSHIP IN THE ORGANIZATION

- 1. In a letter dated 2 November 2017, the Cook Islands applied for membership in the International Organization for Migration. The Director General replied to this letter on 13 November 2017. Both documents are available upon request. An appropriate item will be included in the provisional agenda of the 108th Session of the Council.
- 2. In its letter, the Government of the Cook Islands accepts the Constitution, and confirms that it has completed all the required internal procedures according to its constitution and applicable rules for this application for membership in IOM. It also states that it will fulfil all obligations of membership from the date the IOM Council accepts this application for membership, including to make a financial contribution to the administrative requirements of the Organization, the rate of which will be agreed upon by the IOM Council and the Government.
- 3. In accordance with Article 2(b) of the Constitution, the Council is required to make a decision regarding the application of the Cook Islands for membership and the rate of its financial contribution to the administrative requirements of the Organization, which the Director General recommends should be assessed at 0.0011 per cent of the total contributions required from Member States to the Administrative Part of the Budget.
- 4. A draft resolution concerning this application is submitted separately to the Council for its consideration.
