APPLICATION BY THE LATIN AMERICAN AND CARIBBEAN PARLIAMENT FOR REPRESENTATION BY AN OBSERVER

- 1. In a letter dated 24 March 2017, the Latin American and Caribbean Parliament (Parlatino) made a formal application for Parlatino to be accorded observer status at meetings of the IOM Council. The Director General replied to this letter on 22 June 2017. Both documents are available upon request. An appropriate item will be included in the provisional agenda of the 108th Session of the Council.
- 2. This matter falls under rule 10 of the Rules of Procedure of the Council which provides that the Council may invite, upon their application, intergovernmental organizations concerned with migration, refugees or human resources to be represented at its meetings.
- 3. A draft resolution concerning this application is submitted separately to the Council for its consideration.
