#### Statement by Latvia

Latvia acknowledges growing need for the systematic accumulation of the knowledge, lessons learned and experience IOM gains from its operational activities. In this regard, we would see the development of the Organizations' policy expertise within the Organization's core structure thus ensuring its coherence and sustainability.

Nevertheless, we would like to encourage the Organization to explore all avenues that would contribute to the strengthening of the essential elements of the Organization - responsiveness, efficiency, cost-effectiveness and independence.
