APPLICATION BY THE INTERNATIONAL MONETARY FUND FOR REPRESENTATION BY AN OBSERVER

- 1. In a letter dated 18 December 2017, the International Monetary Fund (IMF) made a formal application for the IMF to be accorded observer status at meetings of the IOM Council. The Director General replied to this letter on 17 January 2018. Both documents are available upon request. An appropriate item will be included in the provisional agenda of the 109th Session of the Council.
- 2. This matter falls under rule 10 of the Rules of Procedure of the Council which provides that the Council may invite, upon their application, international organizations, governmental or non-governmental, concerned with migration, refugees or human resources to be represented at its meetings.
- 3. A draft resolution concerning this application is submitted separately to the Council for its consideration.
