Mr. Chairman,
Director General,
Excellencies,
Distinguished Delegates,

On behalf of the Sovereign Order of Malta I wish to reiterate our sincere congratulations to the Director General on her election. We look forward to pursuing under her leadership our cooperation in accordance with the agreement signed between our two institutions in 2007.

The Order of Malta and IOM are engaged in many of the present crisis areas which strongly affect populations on the move. The international network of the Order of Malta remains by the side of the suffering communities in *Ukraine* and in neighbouring countries. We will continue to provide relief services adapted to the situation and needs on the ground. Our aid focuses on psychosocial support for internally displaced persons, the strengthening of the health system, the provision of winter aid and urgently needed relief supplies.

The Director-General's report also refers to the *Venezuelan migrants and refugees*. In this context, Malteser International, the Order of Malta's worldwide relief agency, is specifically committed to the health and food security of vulnerable population groups in the border areas of northeastern *Colombia*.

In *Haiti*, Malteser International is working with partners to build up structural capacity of civil society organizations for water, sanitation and hygiene, disaster preparedness, and food security.

In Africa, the Order of Malta is providing support to some of the large numbers of refugees and displaced people created by the ongoing instability in several countries that cuts across national borders. In the *Democratic Republic of the Congo*, for example, our projects focus on improving living conditions for *South Sudanese refugees* and the host populations through community-based approaches that include bolstering water supply, sanitary and hygiene conditions and medical care.
