Statement by H.E. Ambassador Marie-Thérèse Pictet-Althann

Mr. Chairman,
Madam Director General,
Excellencies,
Distinguished Delegates.

My Delegation thanks the Director General for her comprehensive report. The Sovereign Military Order of Malta's assistance to displaced persons focuses on providing emergency relief, healthcare, socio-medical aid and long-term support for vulnerable populations fleeing conflict, poverty or natural disasters.

While conflicts are spreading, several resulting situations are of particular concern. In Lebanon, the Order of Malta is enhancing its response to the displacement crisis by providing socio-medical care and food aid. In Gaza, where 75% of the population is displaced, we are delivering aid in collaboration with the Latin Patriarchate of Jerusalem.

Assistance to Ukraine remains a high priority as more than 6 million people fled from their homes. Hence, the Order of Malta provides hygiene kits, food items, as well as mental health and psychosocial support for IDP's.

Moreover, we are present alongside migration routes in Europe, offering a wide range of services helping migrants integrate into host communities (food and medical aid, legal and social assistance, etc.).

In Africa, Malteser International continues to support refugees and IDPs in conflict zones as well as in hosting countries where the humanitarian situation is aggravated, for instance in the Democratic Republic of Congo (DRC) and Sudan. Also, the impact of climate change, that affects several regions such as in South Sudan, and the mpox outbreak further contribute to the dramatic situation in many areas.

Finally, in Asia, Malteser International, in partnership with local organizations, is engaged in emergency humanitarian assistance following natural disasters (Afghanistan, Bangladesh, Pakistan, Indonesia, Philippines).
