CLIMATE CHANGE REALITY

Record numbers of internally displaced persons in 2023 (75.9 million). Humanitarian needs continue to grow and are now in excess of 300 million people globally.

IOM'S RECOGNITION

The urgency to identify proactive and cost-effective measures to support States to address climate-induced human mobility and displacement.

Integrating human mobility considerations into national climate strategies.





CAPACITY BUILDING

Strengthening the resilience of communities and governments through initiatives like CADRI, MICIC and Words into Action.





PARTNERSHIPS

Collaborating with UN agencies, governments, civil society, and increasingly the private sector to maximize impact and integrate expertise and technical solutions.





DATA FOR ACTION AND INSIGHT


