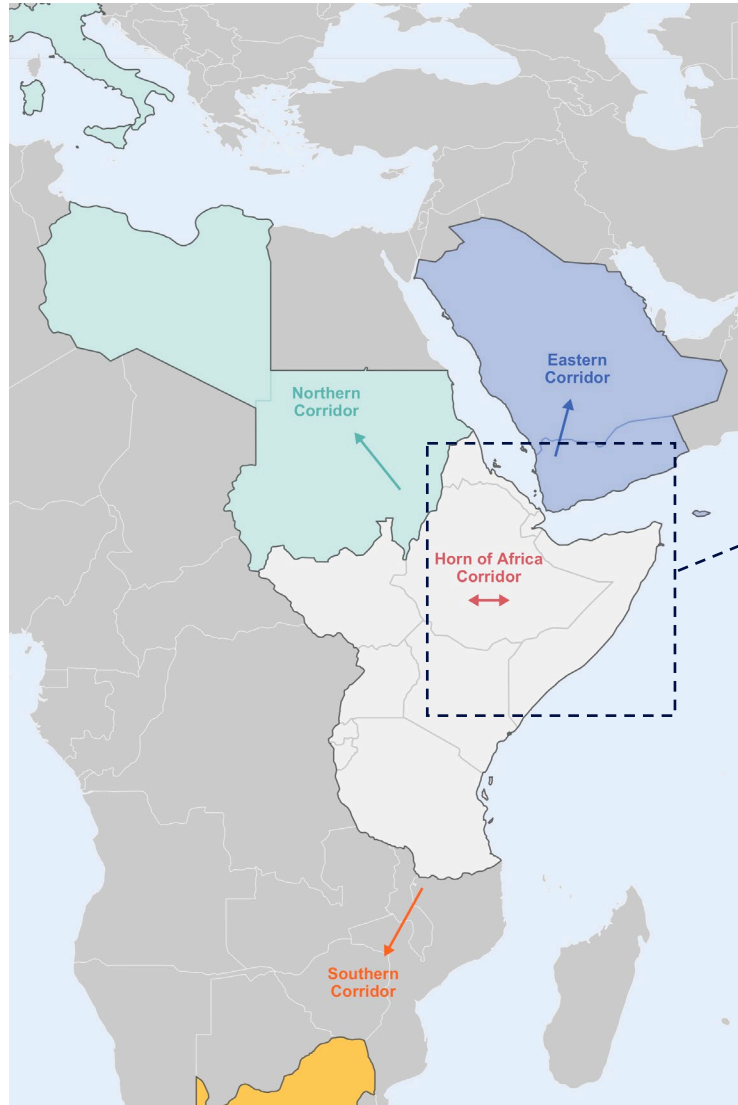

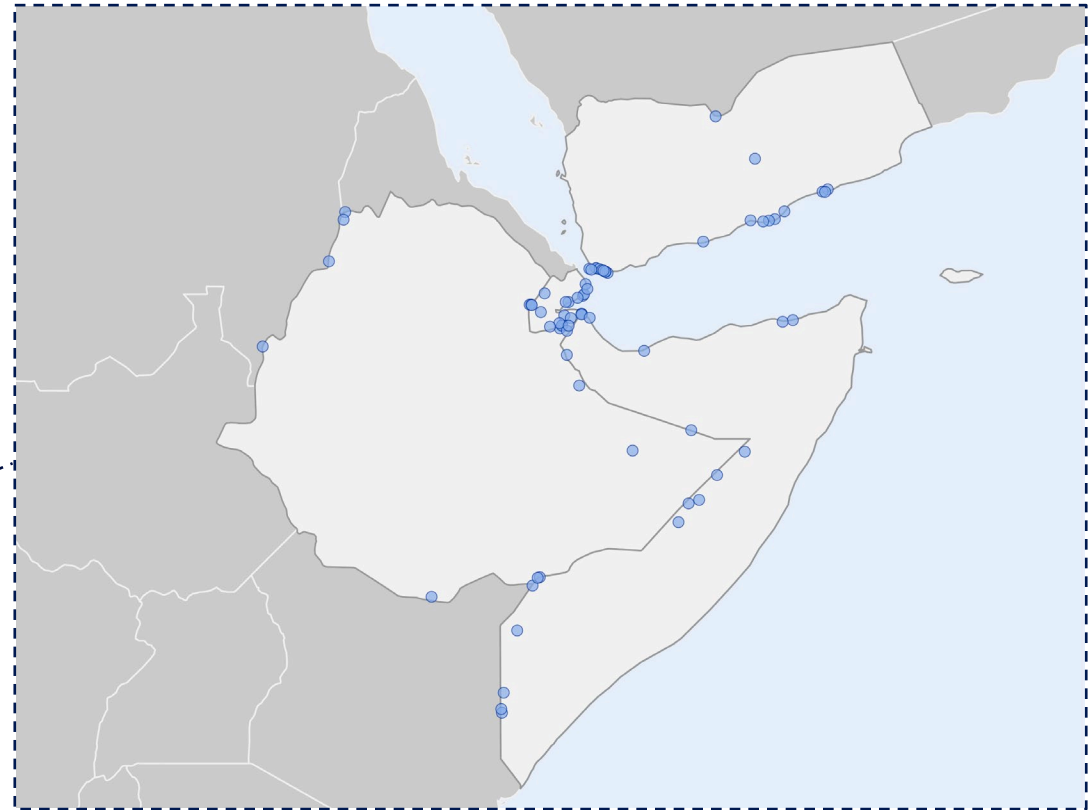

## Migration Corridors



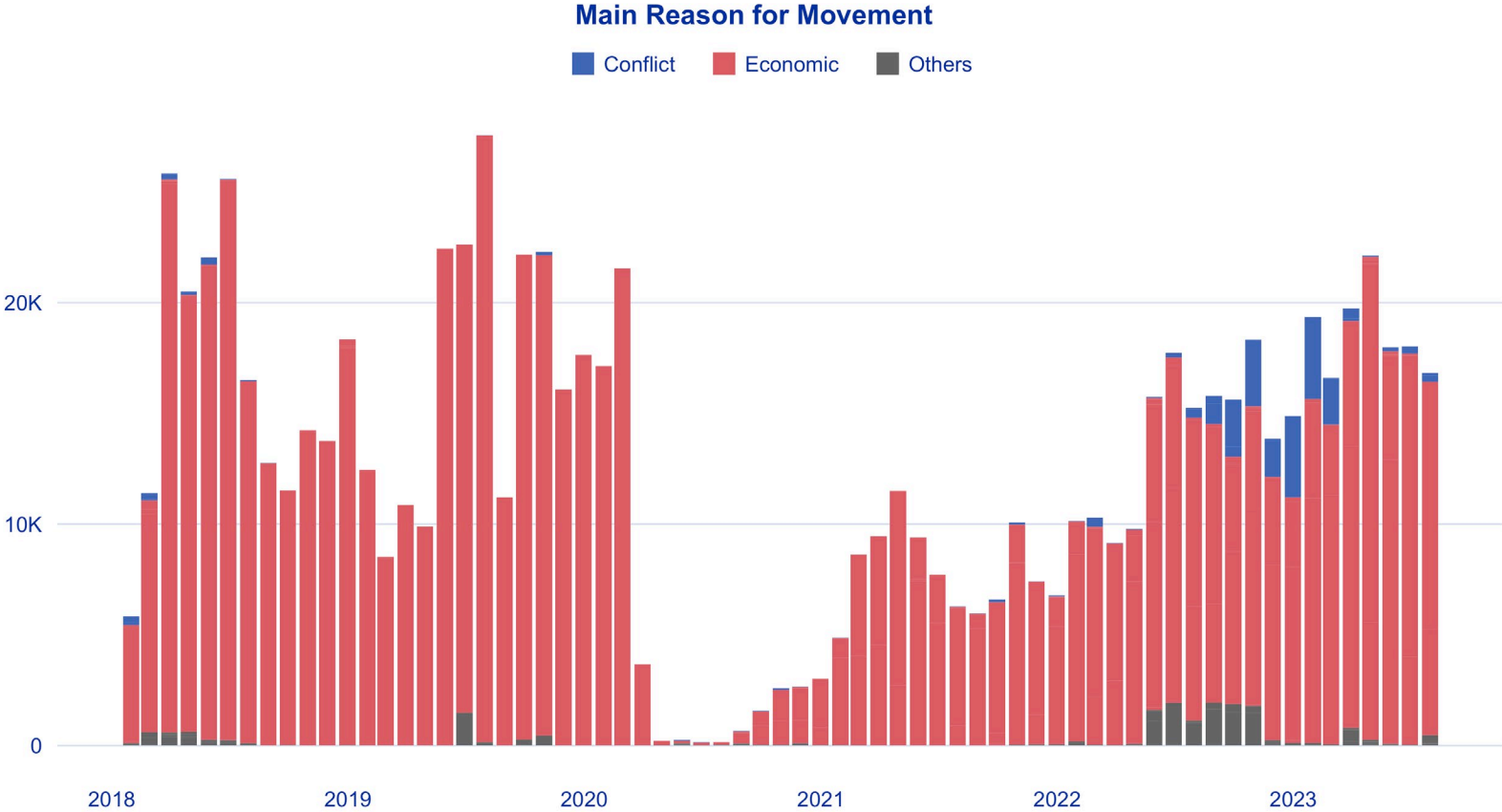
## DTM Flow Monitoring Points

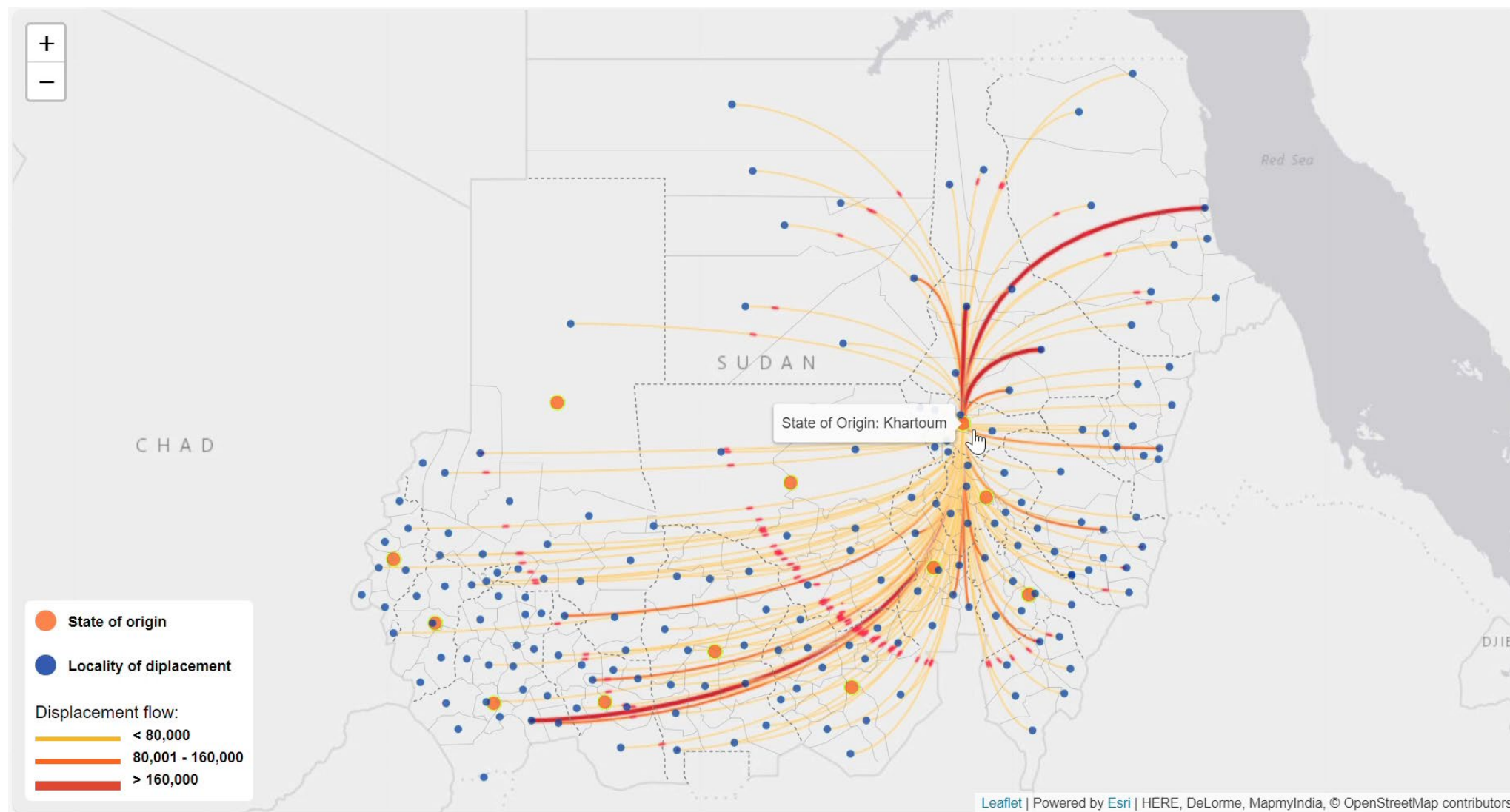

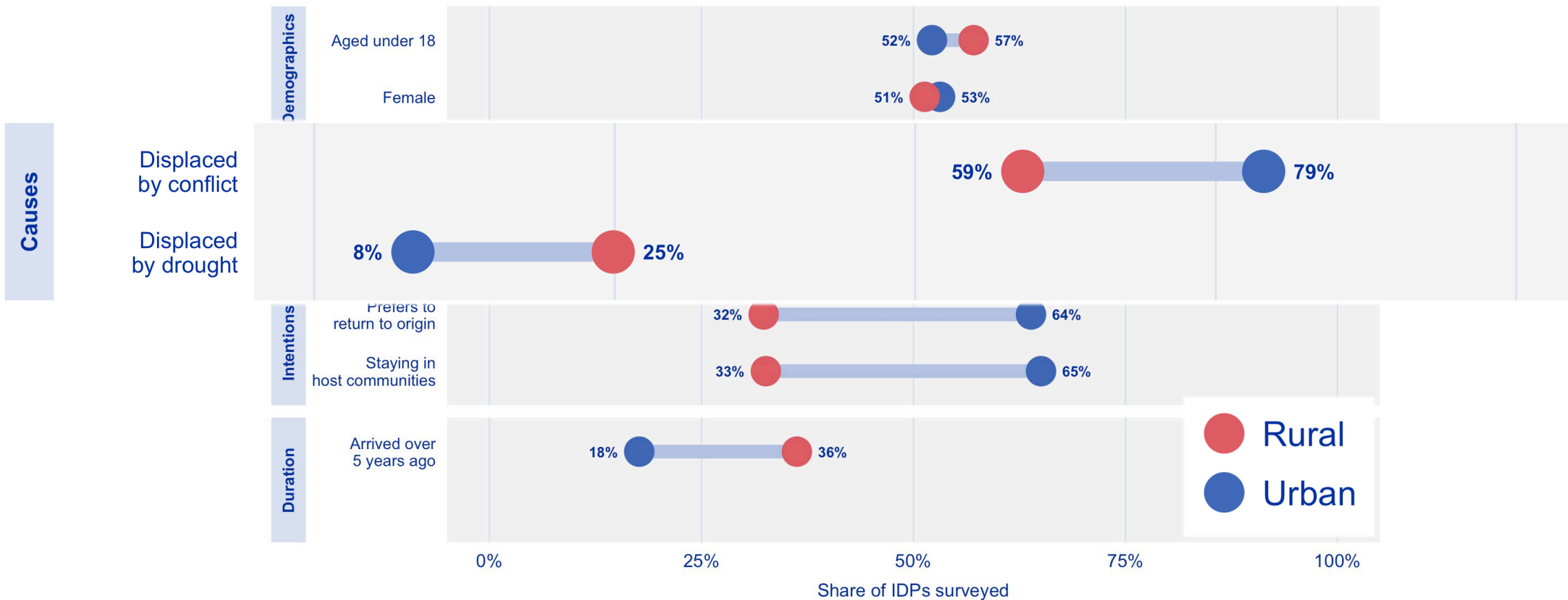

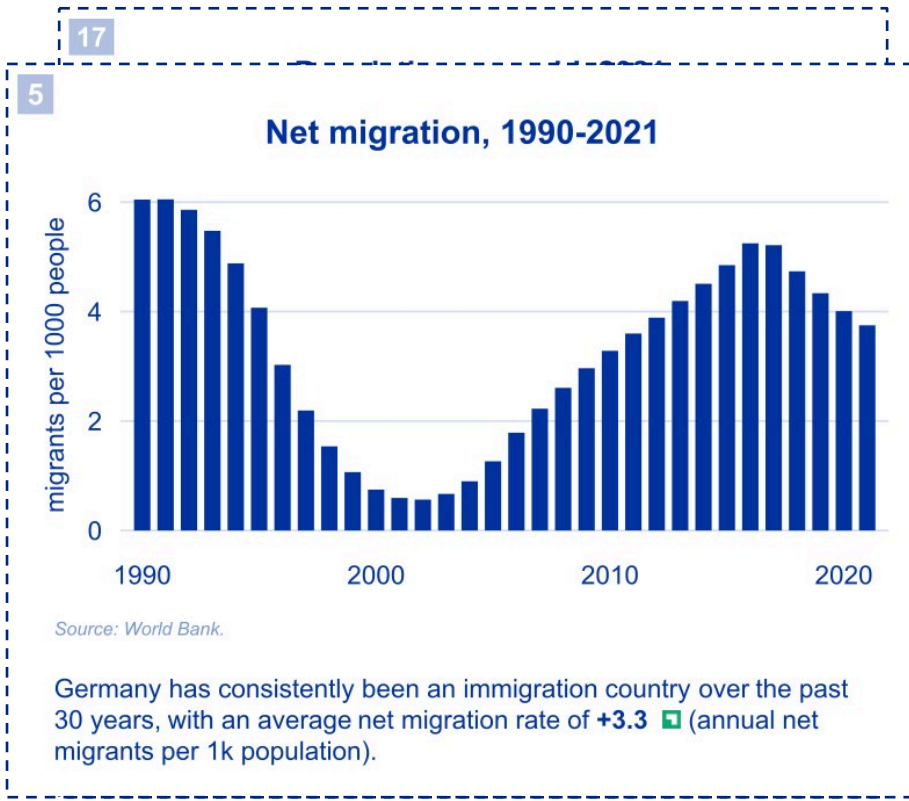

#### 1. POPULATION MOVEMENTS

##### 1 Stock of migrants, 1990-2020

There were **4M** emigrants from Germany in 2020, representing 4.8% of its population. Emigrants have increased by **+0.92%** per year over the past 30 years.

There were **16M** immigrants in Germany in 2020, representing 19% of its population. Immigrants have increased by **+3.3%** per year over the past 30 years.

##### 2 Migrant sex ratios, 2020

54% of emigrants from Germany were female in 2020. 50% of immigrants were female.

##### 3 Where do Germany's emigrants reside?

Emigrants from Germany have moved to comparatively many destination countries.

##### 4 Where do Germany's immigrants come from?

Immigrants in Germany have moved from comparatively many origin countries.

##### 5 Net migration, 1990-2021

Germany has consistently been an immigration country over the past 30 years, with an average net migration rate of **+3.3** (annual net migrants per 1k population).

##### Age dependency ratio

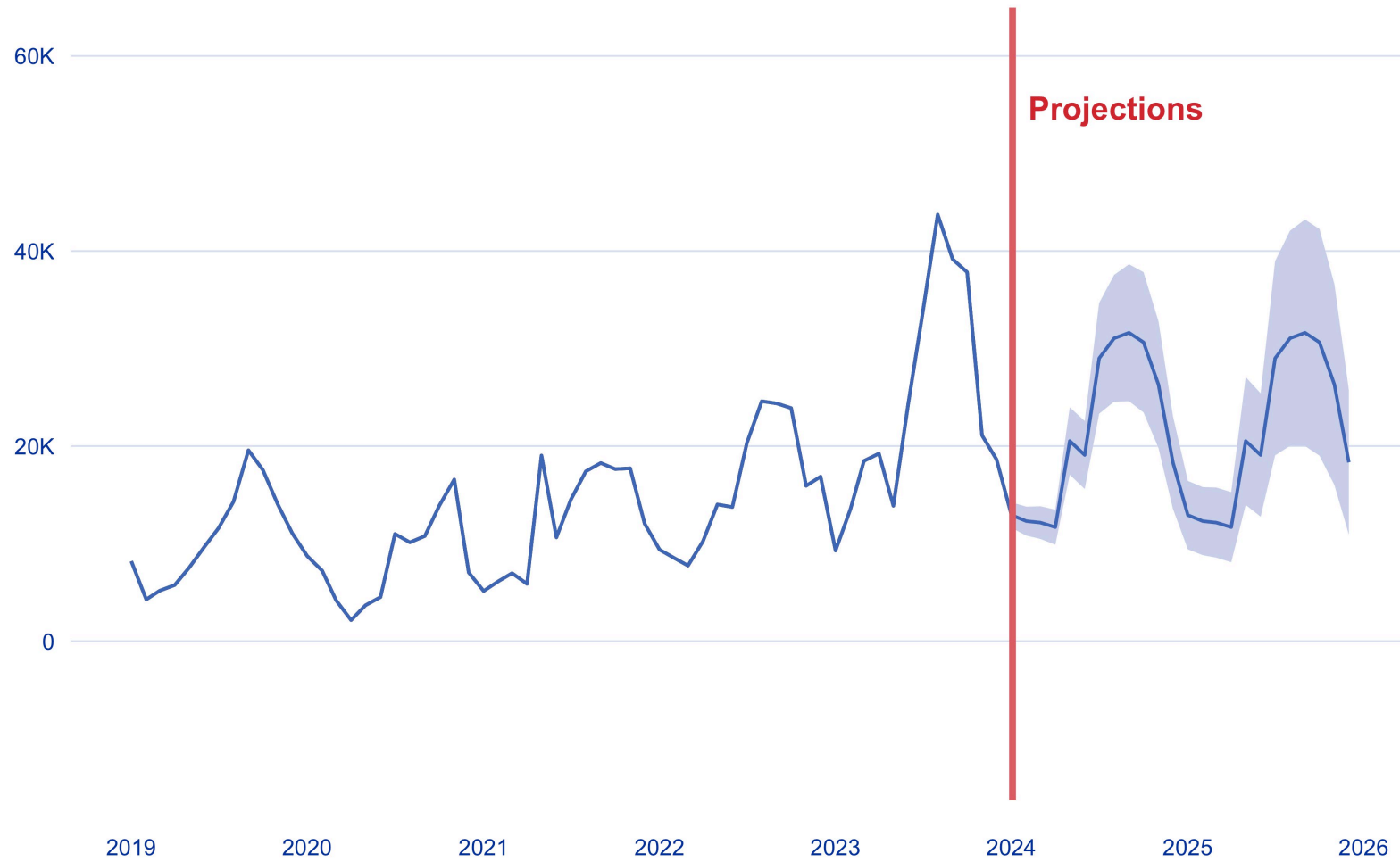
Germany's age dependency ratio (non-working-age working-age pop.) was **54%**.
