RESOLUTION No. 1247 (CII)

(Adopted by the Council at its 529th meeting on 14 June 2013)

**ADMISSION OF THE REPUBLIC OF SURINAME
AS A MEMBER OF THE ORGANIZATION**

The Council,

Having received the request of the Republic of Suriname for admission as a Member of the Organization (MC/2365),

Having been informed that the Republic of Suriname accepts the Constitution of the Organization, and the amendments thereto of 24 November 1998, in accordance with its internal constitutional processes and has undertaken to make a financial contribution to the administrative requirements of the Organization,

Considering that the Republic of Suriname has demonstrated its interest in the principle of the free movement of persons as stated in Article 2(b) of the Constitution,

Convinced that the Republic of Suriname could give valuable assistance towards furthering the purposes of the Organization,

Resolves:

1. That the Republic of Suriname be admitted as a member of the International Organization for Migration, in accordance with the provisions of Article 2(b) of the Constitution, as from the date of the present resolution;
2. That its contribution to the Administrative Part of the Budget be determined at 0.0033 per cent thereof.

Considering that the Republic of Malawi has demonstrated its interest in the principle of the free movement of persons as stated in Article 2(b) of the Constitution,

Convinced that the Republic of Malawi could give valuable assistance towards furthering the purposes of the Organization,

Resolves:

1. That the Republic of Malawi be admitted as a member of the International Organization for Migration, in accordance with the provisions of Article 2(b) of the Constitution, as from the date of the present resolution;

2. That its contribution to the Administrative Part of the Budget be determined at 0.0011 per cent thereof.

CONTRACT OF THE DIRECTOR GENERAL

The Council,

Having elected Mr William Lacy Swing as Director General under the terms of Council Resolution No. 1249 of 14 June 2013,

Having taken cognizance of the clauses contained in the draft contract of employment for the Director General,

Hereby approves the said contract, and

Empowers the Chairperson of the Hundred and Second (Special) Session of the Council, Mr A. Hannan, to sign on behalf of the Organization the contract thus approved, pursuant to Article 18 of the Constitution.
